Public Synopsis of Disciplinary Action

2017:

Officer was suspended for 4 days and surrendered 12 vacation days for neglect of duty and failing to patrol his assigned area. The officer failed to respond for a call of service.

2020:

Officer was suspended for 6 months for neglect of duty and truthfulness.

2021:

Officer was suspended for 6 months for neglect of duty and truthfulness. The officer lied about an illness and failed to report for duty, causing overtime for the department.

2024 – 1ST Quarter:

Officer Matthew Hoelzel was suspended 10 days (5 unpaid days and 5 vacation days forfeited). He utilized his mobile data terminal in his marked patrol vehicle and ran a New Jersey License plate via NJCJIS which returned to a name he recognized. He then shared that information with an unauthorized person.
